Press the power button at the top of your keyboard to turn on/off the computer.



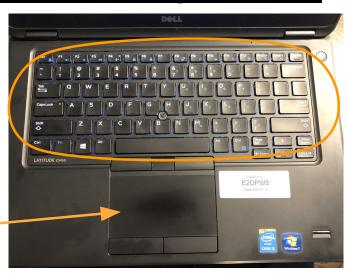

Touchpad -

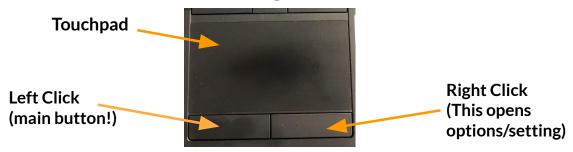

Touchpad



- Use your forefinger to navigate the touchpad.
- Touch in one spot and use one finger for best navigation.
- To drag: press down on pad with one finger while dragging mouse across the screen-let go when done.



Starting up your laptop



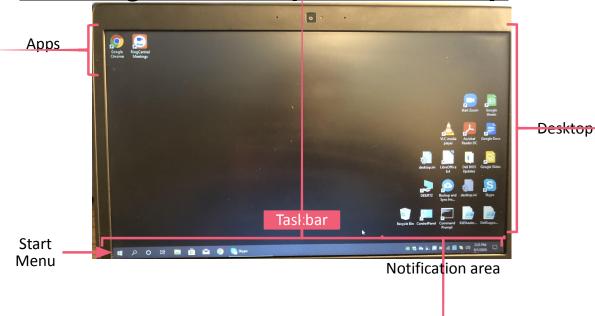
After your laptop is powered on, you will log in.

- You will see "admin"
- Enter E2DPW\$ into the white box (use capital letters)

How to: Connect to Wi-Fi

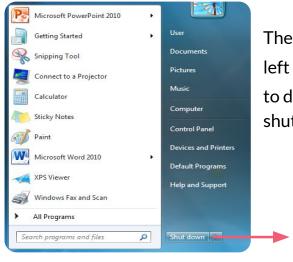




- Select the Network icon on the taskbar.
- A list of nearby Wifi networks will appear.
- Select the Wi-Fi network you want, then select "Connect."
- Type in the network password, if required.
- The Wifi icon should say "connected".

The Start Menu





The Start Menu at the bottom left of your desktop gives access to documents, settings, Microsoft Apps, shutting down the computer & much more.

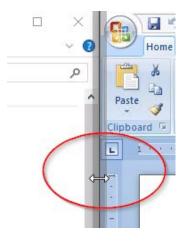


Clicking & Selecting Icons



This icon is called the mouse or cursor:







These arrows will appear when you move your mouse to the edge of an open tab.

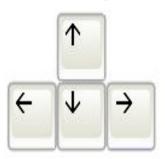


Click and drag on the edge of a tab to resize.



Directional Keys

These arrows found on your keyboard can move the mouse or page up, down, left and right.



When an open window is taking up your entire screen, press the "escape" key at the top left of your keyboard to exit the window or make it smaller.



Special Keys

Space Bar (bottom middle of keyboard)



After typing, click "Enter" to search!

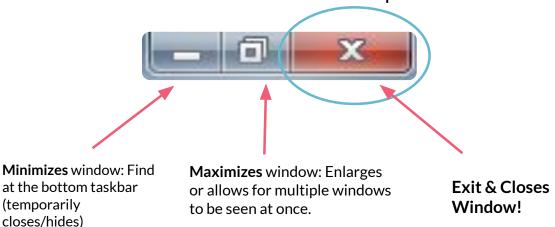




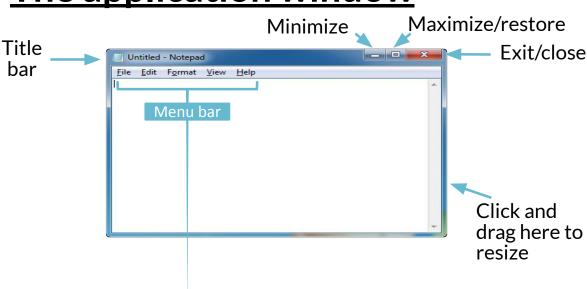
Hold down the "Shift" button while typing a letter to capitalize!

• Each window will have these three options:



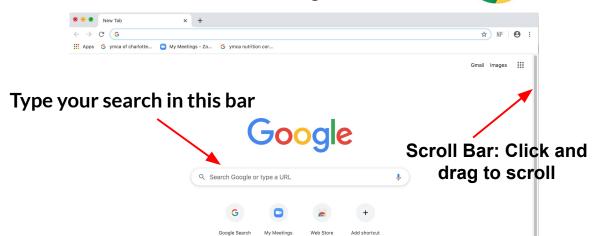

Visiting a Website



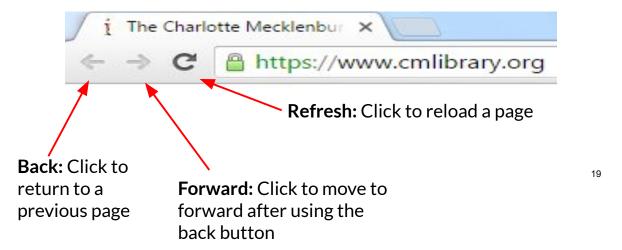


Web Address (URL) – <u>www.cmlibrary.org</u> URLs never have the @ symbol in them. Those are reserved for email addresses.

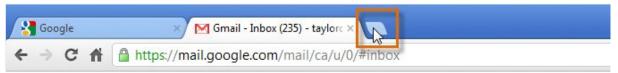
Browser Buttons



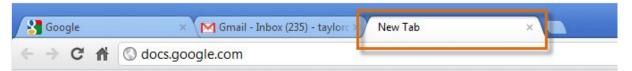
How to open a Tab:



1. Click the **New tab** button to the right of open tabs.



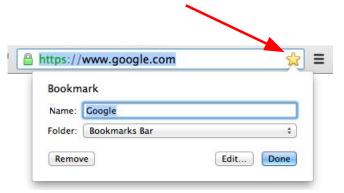
2. The **new tab** will appear. Click in the address bar. Type a web address and press **Enter** to navigate to a new page.





How to: Bookmark (save a website)

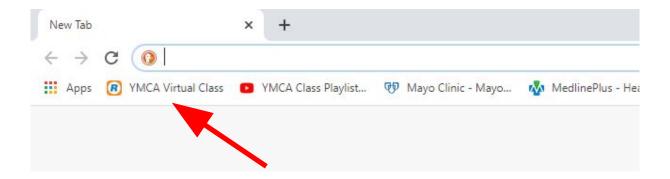
- Click on Google Chrome
- Then type in www.google.com
- Search "YMCA Charlotte"
- Click on YMCA Website
- Click on star in search bar to save to bookmark tab

How to access Zoom:

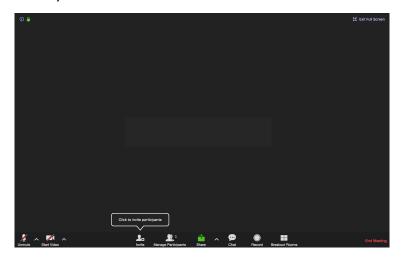
You will access the class each week by accessing Google Chrome and clicking on the YMCA Virtual Class bookmark:
